| Sunday 2 nd Nov 2025 | Election for Management Committee will take place on Sunday 2nd November 2025. Voting start 12:30pm and end at 3:30pm (short break for Zuhr prayer at 1:15pm – 1.50pm). The Board of Trustees will manage the election process and will appoint a number of independent election panel members. Election results will be announced and displayed as soon as all Ballot papers have been counted and verified. |

Election process:

- The **Board of Trustees** will manage the election process and appoint a number of independent members to form an **Election Panel**.
- Members of the Board of Trustees and the Election Panel must remain neutral throughout the process. They must not endorse, support, or campaign for or against any candidate(s).
- Should any candidate wish to withdraw, candidates withdrawals must be submitted via email to <u>trustees@swanseamosque.org</u> by Monday, 20th October 2025.
- By <u>Friday 24th October 2025</u> all candidate names and details will be published (surname alphabetically ordered)
 and displayed on the Mosque notice boards.
- Election will take place on **Sunday 2nd November 2025** (see above for further details.)
- There will be a total of 8 places up for election.
- Each ballot paper **must have exactly eight (8)** candidates selected. Any ballot paper with more or fewer than 8 selected candidates will be **deemed invalid**. The top 8 candidates with the highest number of votes will be elected.
- Results will be announced and displayed on the Mosque notice boards as soon as counting has been completed and verified.
- Any form of negative campaigning by candidates or their supporting members, whether in person or through third parties will not be tolerated and may lead to suspension.

Please note:

- All members are strongly encouraged to take note of and bring their membership number, which can be found in confirmation emails or letters.
- Proof of ID may be requested to verify membership on election day.

Feedback and Concerns regarding the Election:

- Only written submissions will be addressed. We regret that verbal concerns cannot be accepted.
- We will respond only to feedback submitted by individuals. Group feedback or submissions made on behalf of third parties will not be considered.
